Alcohol-free remedies

The Bach Centre is pleased to announce the availability of alcohol-free Bach remedies by mail order. The new remedies are especially suitable for children and animals, and for people who want to avoid alcohol for reasons of health or belief.

The remedies contain mother tinctures made at the Bach Centre, diluted into a carrying medium that is 80% glycerine, 20% water. Although alcohol is used in the preparation of the mother tinctures, the dilution process means the finished remedies can be classed as alcohol-free under UK food regulations.

The alcohol-free remedies are full-strength stock remedies. Dosage is the same as for the traditional alcohol-based product.

This is the first time genuine Bach remedies have been available in this form in the UK. The Bach Centre can supply all 38 single remedies in traditional 10ml dropper bottles.
